<p>Brazilian JiuJitsu</p> <p>Cost: \$110</p>	K-2	<p>Come learn Brazilian Jiu Jitsu in a class designed for young kids! Brazilian Jiu Jitsu is a grappling martial art that uses leverage and angles; there is no striking in Jiu Jitsu. And it doesn't matter your size or strength – anyone can be a Jiu Jitsu martial artist! Returning students are welcome – you will learn new skills and take on leadership roles. <i>Instructor: North South Jiusitu/Adam and Karen Peterson</i></p>
<p>Civil Engineering: Bridge Building</p> <p>Cost: \$100</p>	3-5	<p>You will learn about different types of bridges and civil engineering through a realistic hands-on problem-solving experience. Using the engineering design process and STEM skills, you will design a bridge on software, then build it and test it. The bridge will have to meet load, safety and budget constraints. <i>Instructor: Montclair Learning Center</i></p>
<p>Enjoy Pottery Everywhere</p> <p>Cost \$95</p>	3-5	<p>A class for aspiring artists of all levels who want to learn how to work with clay. You will explore different types of clay, techniques such as pinch pot, coil pot, slab building, and more. This is an imaginative hands-on class that allows you to enjoy pottery everywhere. New projects every session. <i>Instructor: Potterywise</i></p>
<p>Friendship Bracelets</p> <p>Cost: \$95</p>	K-1	<p>Learn how to make friendship bracelets! Using different techniques and colors, you will learn how to make fun and creative patterns and designs. <i>Instructor: Amanda Mayoff</i></p>
<p>Italian (K-2)</p> <p>Cost: \$110</p>	K-2	<p>Ciao! This class is for students who took the Fall and Winter Italian classes. This session you will learn how to read an Italian storybook; translate the action into dance, play or puppetry; play a game in Italian; and describe and give information about yourself. (Students must have taken Fall and Winter Italian to register.) <i>Instructor: Benedetta Balsimelli, La Freccia Azzurra</i></p>

Tuesday (8 weeks)

<p>Comic Design</p> <p>Cost: \$140</p>	3-5	<p>In this class you will research the art of comics and produce original artwork. You'll learn character development by studying anatomy, proper proportions of face, and ways to portray facial and physical expressions. You will design a universe and form narrative for your character using investigation and storyboard techniques. <i>Instructor: Urban Arts LLC</i></p>
<p>Embroidery</p> <p>Cost: \$100</p>	3-5	<p>Learn how to decorate fabric or other materials through embroidery. You'll learn basic techniques and stitches in this new class. <i>Instructor: Sew Leana/Leana Lu</i></p>
<p>Garden-to-table Culinary Fun</p> <p>Cost: \$170</p>	2-5	<p>Learn where food comes from and why eating fresh is best for a healthy body! Each session you will prepare and eat a new food, and take home the recipe to share with your family. Whole wheat pizza, dumplings, and sweet potato pancakes are just some of the foods you'll learn to make. You will learn to cook with fresh natural foods through games and hands-on activities while learning about nutrition. (Lessons are designed to meet the needs of all children and their families.) <i>Instructor: HealthBarn USA</i></p>

Outdoor Parisi Speed & Agility Cost \$120	2-5	New for Spring - this class will meet outdoors weather permitting. This class is perfect if you want to become faster in any direction and have fun doing it! You will play games and work on sprint mechanics such as acceleration and top speed as well as change of direction techniques. This class combines core athletic training and specific movement skill training. <i>Instructor: Craig Stoddard, Parisi Speed School</i>
Vet's Academy Cost: \$110	K-2	If you love animals this is the class for you! During this course, we will learn how vets take care of pets, farm and zoo animals. Each week you will discuss a different type of animal and veterinary medical techniques at an age-appropriate level and complete a hands-on stem activity. (There are no live animals involved in this class.) <i>Instructor: Montclair Learning Center</i>
Wednesday (8 weeks)		
African Dance Cost \$90	1-5	This movement class is based on the rhythmic sounds of Afro-Caribbean beat and drum. Your feet will guide you as your ears find the beat and your heart follows the moves. This class will help build confidence not only in yourself but in how you move. <i>Instructor: Ms. Henry</i>
Edgemontapella Cost: \$100	3-5	Are you a fan of the show "The Sing-Off," the Montclair High School "Passing Notes," or the group "Pentatonix?" Do you enjoy singing in harmony—different voice parts that enrich each other and sound beautiful together? Join Edgemontapella, Edgemont School's a capella group! We are a voices-only ensemble, and we will learn how to sing in harmony. The group will have opportunities to perform at various school events throughout the year. We look forward to having you join us! <i>Instructor: Sam Mellman</i>
Italian (3-5) Cost: \$130	3-5	Ciao! This class is for students who took the Fall and Winter Italian classes. This session you will learn how to read an Italian storybook; translate the action into dance, play or puppetry; play a game in Italian; and describe and give information about yourself. (Students must have taken Fall and Winter Italian to register.) <i>Instructor: Benedetta Balsimelli, La Freccia Azzurra</i>

Travels through Art History \$120	2-5	Let's explore different artists through time! This fun mixed-media class will encourage you to express yourself in unique and creative ways while learning about art materials, techniques and artists through history. Topics could include animals, places, people, nature and more! <i>Instructor: Peg Kenselaar, Montclair Art Museum</i>
Yoga \$100	K-2	Stretch, strengthen and play! Yoga can provide a foundation for your balance and strength that will last a lifetime. Classes include posture clinic (yoga poses and correct alignment), group games encouraging cooperation and coordination, and stories that provide tools for positive self-esteem and healthy lifestyle choices. <i>Instructor: Ms. Olivi</i>

Birds, Blooms and Bugs \$120	K-2	Explore nature and its many wonders! Create paintings, sculptures, prints and more as you learn fun facts about the natural world around us. Subject matter may include, but is not limited to, animals, plant life, life cycles, insects, biomes and more! <i>Instructor: Peg Kenselaar, Montclair Art Museum</i>
Turn Your Story into a Video Game Cost: \$90	3-5	Bloxels EDU is the most intuitive platform for creating video games in the classroom. When you build your own games, you become the writer, artist, designer and developer of your own interactive stories. You will work in groups to plan and produce your own video game using the Bloxels platform and Bloxels Hub app. (Note: the first class will be May 2nd) <i>Instructor: Ms. Cioffi</i>
Yoga & Meditation Cost: \$100	3-5	Yoga and meditation build the groundwork for a healthy lifestyle and are essential for fast-growing bodies. We will explore the practice of yoga through cooperative games, stories, postures, mindfulness, and relaxation. You will also be introduced to multiple meditation practices and be given tools to become more mindful in your everyday life. <i>Instructor: Ms. Olivi</i>

Improv Acting Cost: \$90	K-2	Give your imagination a blast of spontaneity - the first step to understanding what improvisation and acting is all about! In this fun and supportive class, you will play improv-based games and role-playing to stretch your imagination and discover the endless creativity in yourself. (Appropriate for new and returning student.)! <i>Instructor: NJ School of Dramatic Arts</i>

ENRICHMENT REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ. When you register on-line, you are agreeing to the following rules and regulations:

- **Registration.** Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. If your child is placed on a wait list, you will be notified if a spot opens up.
- **Withdrawing from a class.** Full refunds are only given if you notify edgemontenrichment@gmail.com before the first day of class. Partial refunds are not given.
- **Class cancellations.** PTA Enrichment reserves the right to cancel a class if not enough students register. You will be notified if a class is cancelled and given a full refund.
- **Pick-up.** Your child must be picked up by 4:00 PM unless they are going to after-care. If your child is picked up late more than three times, they may be asked to leave the program without a refund.
- **Cancellations/Make-up classes.** If a class is cancelled by the instructor, you will be notified by telephone and email. Your child will go home by his/her usual mode of transportation at the regular dismissal time of 2:35 PM, unless you inform the Main Office otherwise. Whenever possible, a make-up class will be scheduled the week after the session ends. In the event a make-up class cannot be scheduled, you will be refunded the fee for the cancelled class.
- **Snow days/School closings:** In the event of a snow day or unplanned school closing, all Enrichment classes are automatically cancelled for that day. Whenever possible, a make-up class will be scheduled the week after the session ends. In the event a make-up class cannot be scheduled, you will NOT be refunded the fee for the class.
- **Snack policy:** Enrichment students are permitted to bring a **peanut- and tree nut-free snack** to eat between dismissal and Enrichment. School staff will direct all students to go to the multi-purpose room to eat their snacks. Due to MPS policy, food is allowed ONLY in the multi-purpose room. We appreciate your cooperation with this policy.
- **Allergies.** There is no nurse on duty during Enrichment. If your child requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to provide an additional EpiPen for Enrichment with a copy of the care plan. The on-site supervisor and class instructors are not able to administer EpiPens.
- **Class disruptions.** If your child displays behavior issues that disrupt the class or others' ability to enjoy it, they may be removed from the class by the on-site supervisor and you will be contacted. Multiple removals can result in your child being dismissed from the class, without refund.
