Monday (7 weeks)		
Animal Art Cost: \$150	K-2	Let's explore endangered animal species from the land, sea and sky. We will travel to different biomes around the planet and create one of a kind drawings, paintings, sculptures and masks of animals! Let's make amazing art and learn what we can do to help animals and our planet. <i>Instructor: Peg Kenselaar, Montclair Art Museum</i>
Fitness Olympics Cost: \$110	K-2	Join us for a variety-pack of sports with a new activity each week! Some of the activities include; soccer, volleyball, basketball, rugby, field, kickball, & track. The focus will be on team play, skill building, and wellness. You'll have fun and learn valuable life skills of collaboration and perseverance. <i>Instructor: Alphabest</i>
Brixology Cost: \$115	K-5	Brixology sets the foundation for our next generation of makers! You will learn about different types of engineering and then team up to construct a different engineering-themed project using Lego bricks. You learn about aerospace engineering while assembling a space station and explore mechanical engineering as you build boats and vehicles. That's not all, from carnival rides to drawing machines, mechanical animals to truss bridges; you are future engineers. <i>Instructor: Mad Science of Northeast NJ</i>
Beyond Beads Cost: \$110	2-5	Come in, choose materials and get to making! Techniques will be shared and you will discuss ideas for three dimensional, more sculptural, detailed projects to pursue. You will also have an option to make simpler jewelry. Focus on problem solving, patience and handcrafting your own creations. <i>Instructor: Ms. Mayoff, Edgemont</i>
Tuesday (8 weeks)		
Beads & More Cost: \$120	K-2	Basic beading using the simplest techniques to meet you at your own level and interests, such as kids' styles bracelets and necklaces. Focused on having a relaxed moment, independence and building fine motor skills. <i>Instructor: Ms. Mayoff, Edgemont</i>
Garden-to-Table Culinary Fun Cost: \$150	K-5	Chefs in Training! Learn where food comes from and why cooking and eating fresh is best for a healthy body! Each session you will prepare and eat a new recipe, and take home these skills to share with your family. Whole wheat pizza, quesadillas and apple crisp are just some of the foods you'll learn to make. You will learn to cook with fresh natural foods and learn about nutrition through games and hands-on activities. (Lessons are designed to meet the needs of all children and their families and mixed ages will be encouraged to work together.) <i>Instructor: Healthbarn USA</i>
Yoga & Mindfulness Cost: \$115	3-5	Yoga and mindfulness build the groundwork for a healthy lifestyle and are essential for fast-growing bodies. We will explore the practice of yoga through cooperative games, stories, postures, mindfulness activities, and relaxation. You will also be introduced to multiple practices and learn tools to become more mindful in your everyday life. <i>Instructor: Ms. Olivi, Edgemont</i>
Sign Language Cost \$105	3-5	In this class you'll be introduced to the basics of sign language including the alphabet, simple vocabulary, and common expressions used in everyday life. You'll learn conversational skills, to sign to song, and to sign holidays and celebrations. Cartooning: DIY Comic Books Cost \$140	K-2	Create your very own comic book! We provide the cartooning instruction and you fill in the story, dialogue and scenery. Every session consists of one instructional video of a character, followed by Comic Book Development time where you will create unique comic books by adding characters, story, dialogue and scenery. You will add new characters each week and see how their stories take shape. <i>Instructor: Alphabest</i>
Shockingly Sticky Science Cost: \$135	K-3	Learn Watts-Up with electricity and build your own static tubes and learn the marvels of magnets in Magnetic Magic as you construct your own Magnet Maze. Then get sticky with polymers while we stretch it out with slime! Don't look now...or well...actually do look as we use our eyes in Optical Illusions and create your own periscope. Just when you thought you've had all of the awesome science you can handle, it's time for lights, color, action!, as we create indoor fireworks and lighten things up with fantastic lights and color displays. <i>Instructor: Mad Science of Northeast NJ</i>
Delightful Rhythms Cost: \$115	1-5	This is an African dance class. The music is based on the rhythmic sounds of Afro-Caribbean beat and drum. While in this class your feet will guide you as your ears find the beat and your heart follows the moves. You'll build confidence while playing with a new culture of moves and style. <i>Instructor: Ms. Henry, Edgemont</i>
Pop Art Cost: \$155	3-5	Create one of a kind portraits, everyday items, animals and more inspired by Pop Artists! We will use mixed media to make paintings, drawings, prints, and sculptures. Color, creativity, imagination and fun are the main ingredients to create lasting memories! <i>Instructor: Peg Kenselaar, Montclair Art Museum</i>

Karate Cost: \$115	K-2	Budo Kin Kai Karate with Master Karrin is a fun, non-contact karate program. You'll enjoy engaging activities that utilize physical exercise, martial arts skills, and games. This class is designed to specifically target and build the mind, body and social skills of each student in the most fun, effective, and creative way possible. <i>Instructor: Master Karrin Pitt</i>
Yoga Cost: \$100	K-2	Stretch, strengthen and play! Yoga can provide a foundation for your balance and strength that will last a lifetime. Classes include posture clinic (yoga poses and correct alignment), group games encouraging cooperation and coordination, and stories that provide tools for positive self-esteem and healthy lifestyle choices. <i>Instructor: Ms. Olivi, Edgemont</i>

Chess in a Nutshell Cost: \$110	3-5	Learn the rules and etiquette of chess, no matter your skill level. Each session will include "mini-lessons" and opportunities for you to hone your skills by playing practice games with each other. The course will cover subjects such as tactics and strategies, how to notate games, and how to use chess clocks. <i>Instructor: Steve Moctezuma</i>

ENRICHMENT REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ. When you register on-line, you are agreeing to the following rules and regulations:

- **Registration:** Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. If your child is placed on a wait list, you will be notified if a spot opens up.
- **Withdrawing from a class:** Full refunds are only given if you notify enrichment@edgemontpta.org before the first day of class. Partial refunds are not given.
- **Class cancellations:** PTA Enrichment reserves the right to cancel a class if not enough students register. You will be notified if a class is cancelled and given a full refund including the administrative fee.
- **Pick-up & Dismissal Procedure.** For students picked up (and not attending after-care), parents & caregivers must initial the attendance sign-out sheet. Your child must be picked up by 4:00 PM unless they are going to after-care. If your child is picked up late more than three times, they may be asked to leave the program without a refund.
- **Changes in your child's pick-up/dismissal:** If you make changes to the dismissal plan for your child, including your child being picked up by another parent, please email the information to Ms. Mascellino at Imascellino@montclair.k12.nj.us and enrichment@edgemontpta.org so the information can be shared with our Enrichment on-site supervisors.
- **Cancellations/Make-up classes:** If a class is cancelled by the instructor, you will be notified by text and email. Your child will go home by his/her usual mode of transportation at the regular dismissal time of 2:35 PM, unless you inform the Main Office otherwise. Whenever possible, a make-up class will be scheduled the week after the session ends. In the event a make-up class cannot be scheduled, you will be refunded the fee for the cancelled class.
- **Snow days/School closings:** In the event of a snow day or unplanned school closing, all Enrichment classes are automatically cancelled for that day. Whenever possible, a make-up class will be scheduled the week after the session ends. In the event a make-up class cannot be scheduled, you will NOT be refunded the fee for the class.
- **Snack policy:** Enrichment students are permitted to bring a **peanut- and tree nut-free snack** to eat between dismissal and Enrichment. School staff will direct all students to go to the multi-purpose room to eat their snacks. Due to MPS policy, food is allowed ONLY in the multi-purpose room. We appreciate your cooperation with this policy.
- **Allergies:** There is no school nurse on site during during Enrichment. If your child requires an EpiPen/Auvi-Q, it is your responsibility to provide an additional EpiPen/Auvi-Q for Enrichment with a copy of the care plan. The on-site supervisors and/or office staff are trained to administer EpiPen/Auvi-Q in a medical emergency.
- **Class disruptions:** If your child displays behavior issues that disrupt the class or others' ability to enjoy it, they may be removed from the class by the on-site supervisor and you will be contacted. Multiple removals can result in your child being dismissed from the class, without refund.
